



DEEP SEA TUNA FISHING WEST OF THE HEBRIDES

TRIP INFORMATION

Our tuna fishing season runs from 1st September until 15th October. We run our trips from Leverburgh, South Harris. We leave at 8am but ask you to be there 15 minutes beforehand for a safety briefing and aim to arrive back in Harris at 6.30pm but this may vary depending on the fishing. The same itinerary also applies for the two and three day trip option where we will return to Harris each night.

All fishing gear is provided and each each of the six passengers will man their own rod. Passengers are required to take a packed lunch and wear warm, waterproof clothing. Tea and coffee is available on board the vessel.

BOOKING POLICY

We ask for a deposit of £80 per person to confirm your booking and this is returned to you if we are unable to take you out. The balance is payable on the day of your trip as there is a card machine on the boat.

It is very important that you contact us before your trip with a phone number for when you are in Harris. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

There must be six passengers to make a trip viable. If your booking is for less than six people we will arrange collaboration with other passengers.

Our trips run on a catch and release basis. A.M.S works in partnership with Marine Scotland towards the conservation of bluefin tuna. Every tuna caught is carefully unhooked, measured and/or weighed and tagged with a unique number. This information is then sent to Marine Scotland where relevant information such as sex, location, dates and times etc are obtained to help in the conservation of bluefin tuna.
